The resident experts will support the MeHSIP team in Luxembourg in identifying and supporting the preparation for financing of key water, waste water and solid waste projects in the Southern Mediterranean region. They will report to the MeHSIP II team in Luxembourg and be in regular contact with staff in the EIB local offices.</li> <li><i>ii.</i> The pool of experts will provide ad-hoc support to the four resident experts and to the MeHSIP II team based in Luxembourg, to whom they will report.</li> </ul>
