Objective of the project:	<p>The specific objective of the Assignment is to enhance the professional capacity of the persons appointed by contracting authorities to carry out IPFC, according to article 9, paragraph 6 of the Government Ordinance no. 119/1999 (the Ordinance 119), on public procurement operations and, in particular, on the following operations: Contracting strategy; Draft contracts/framework agreements in tender dossiers; Draft contract/framework agreement before signature by the Manager of the Public Entity; Addenda to contracts, before signature by the Authorizing Officer.</p> <p>The expected result of the Assignment is that up to 300 persons in charge with IPFC are trained by the end of the Assignment (tentatively mid of September 2017) and their knowledge and abilities in checking public procurement related operations are improved, contributing thus to improvement of the legality and regularity of operations checked.</p>
